Using your studied knowledge in film studies, communication or fine arts, you will read, analyze and produce a translation of a script coverage report on major motion picture screenplays received from TNGA's internal readers into Chinese. In addition the candidate must be able to communicate smoothly in Mandarin or Cantonese with TNGA's client(s) and should the client require, be able to attend major film festivals when requested (Sundance Film Festival (Jan); Berlin International Film Festival (Feb); Cannes International Film Festival (May); Toronto International Film Festival (Sept) and American Film Market (Nov).

The translated Coverage report will be based on the 'English' report plus an opinion letter on potential theatrical, DVD, Television (Pay-Per-View, Pay and Free TV) and Ancillary exploitation in China, Hong Kong and Taiwan. Interested candidates must be fluent (oral & written) in Mandarin and Cantonese languages and have proficient computer skills sufficient to task. Pay rate : Non-paying position during training period. \$25 per report honorarium thereafter. Expected turn around: 3-4 page translated report 3 days after receipt of English reader report. Compensation for specific tasks i.e. communication with client or attendance at film festivals will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis.
